Why might someone need your blood donation?

- 1. A **serious injury** that's caused major blood loss
- 2. Surgery that's caused a lot of blood loss Blood loss after childbirth
- 3. A liver problem that makes your body unable to create certain blood parts
- 4. A bleeding disorder, such as hemophilia
- 5. An illness that causes reduced or poor-quality RBCs (anemia)
- 6. Kidney failure, which causes problems with blood cell production
- 7. Treatment for cancer (**chemotherapy**) that slows down your body's production of blood cells

Any one of these things could happen to you or your family or your neighbors or someone in your community. Please sign up to donate on 3-27 or ask someone you know to donate in your place. Ask RRC members Hal Coleman, Bob Hagan, Susan Rumble,Jonathan Crooks...The emergency need for a life saving blood transfusion comes without warning. Won't you please help to make sure the blood is there when a life saving need occurs?


